Exploration Program



SD61 and [West Coast Adventure College](#) have partnered together to offer an amazing 8-week summer program for students interested in exploring the Adventure Tourism Industry. The TALE Program provides students with a foundational knowledge in wilderness first aid, navigation, leadership and communication skills, risk management, trip planning and survival skills. Upon completion of the program, students will acquire **8 high school credits** and an invaluable connection with local tourism companies through a **4-week work experience placement**.

Summer Work Experience Placements

[Belleville's Watering Hole & Diner](#) has created a Summer Work Experience opportunity with SD61 for students interested in the Culinary and Hospitality Industry. There are Front of House and Kitchen positions available for students 15 years or older interested in completing this work experience program. Students will need to be available for a variety of daytime/evening/weekend shifts (4-6 hours in length).



[Moksha Yoga](#) has created a Summer Work Experience program called Ambassador Work Experience (AWE) which will require students (16 years or older) to work a total of 32 hours over 4 consecutive weeks completed in two 4-hour shifts a week. AWE program participants will be offered unlimited access to classes at the studio during their placement and will be given a certificate of completion, reference letter and a complementary 5 class punch card to the studio after completion of their placement.
